



Price Faculty of Engineering Student Initiative Fund Terms of Use

A student initiative fund has been established by the Price Faculty of Engineering Student Society: University of Manitoba Engineering Society (UMES). As such, this money contributed by the student body shall be used in a manner that benefits the majority of the Engineering student body. UMES will solicit proposals from the student body on an annual basis for the use of funds available.

The use of funds must fall within one of more of the following categories:

1. Furnishings and/or equipment purchases
2. Lectureships
3. Student Research
4. Conferences/professional development events
5. Representational Society Initiatives

Proposals for funds that fall outside of the above-mentioned categories may be granted should all members of the finance committee be present and a majority vote be reached.

The selection of the finance committee shall consist of the following UMES members: Senior Stick, Vice Stick Finance, as well as four additional members of UMES as appointed by the Senior Stick. This may also include, at the discretion of UMES, a seventh member: a staff member of the Price Faculty of Engineering to act both as a representative and voting member of the committee in the capacity of the student initiative fund. The Vice Stick Finance shall be the Chair of the Finance Committee meeting, and shall have a vote and all other privileges of any other Committee Member.
